Since the beginning of AHS, Connie Chang has been an advocate for dental services after she saw that our community cannot be truly healthy if we are burdened with pain and suffering from dental diseases. Tonight, we dedicate this event to Connie and Henry for keeping the vision of comprehensive care alive.

We also honor three organizations and individuals who helped us open a community dental clinic that was only a dream until recently.

Kaiser Permanente: With a lead gift of \$50,000, Kaiser Permanente has allowed AHS to establish the \$1 million dental health campaign and enabled us to raise an additional \$650,000 towards the purchase, renovation and equipment of our community dental clinic

- **Cedillo-Alarcón Community Clinic Investment Act of 2000:** This \$50 million investment in the infrastructure of community clinics has been critical in expanding access to healthcare. AHS received \$250,000 for the renovation and equipment for the clinic.
- **Alameda County Health Care Services Agency:** Tobacco Settlement Capital Improvement funding has also been critical in meeting the infrastructure needs of Alameda County's community health centers. The



\$400,000 grant has enabled us to purchase our dental clinic space and freed us to allocate our resources towards serving more patients.
